Golden Shovel Award Winner!



TSMS was notified that it has been selected as a Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services' **Golden Shovel Award winner** as the top secondary division applicant in the **Best New Garden category!**

The criteria for this award are that the school must have constructed, maintained, and harvested produce from their garden for their first season during the 2016-2017 school year. Back in April, Mr Froemke submitted an entry to the State, responding to questions about the TSMS garden's design and appearance, crop diversity, curriculum integration, school involvement, novel features, and sustainability plan. All went well and we are thrilled to have the garden recognized in this manner!

The school will receive about \$500 in prizes, including a vertical storage shed and a Worm Factory composter with which students can learn about vermiculture (using worms to create compost out of food waste.) Once again we want to thank the Lowe's Charitable and Educational Foundation for providing the funds to the build the garden and the UF/IFAS Leon County Extension Office for their support as well as the wonderful parents who helped build the garden and the teachers and students who are now making good use of it. 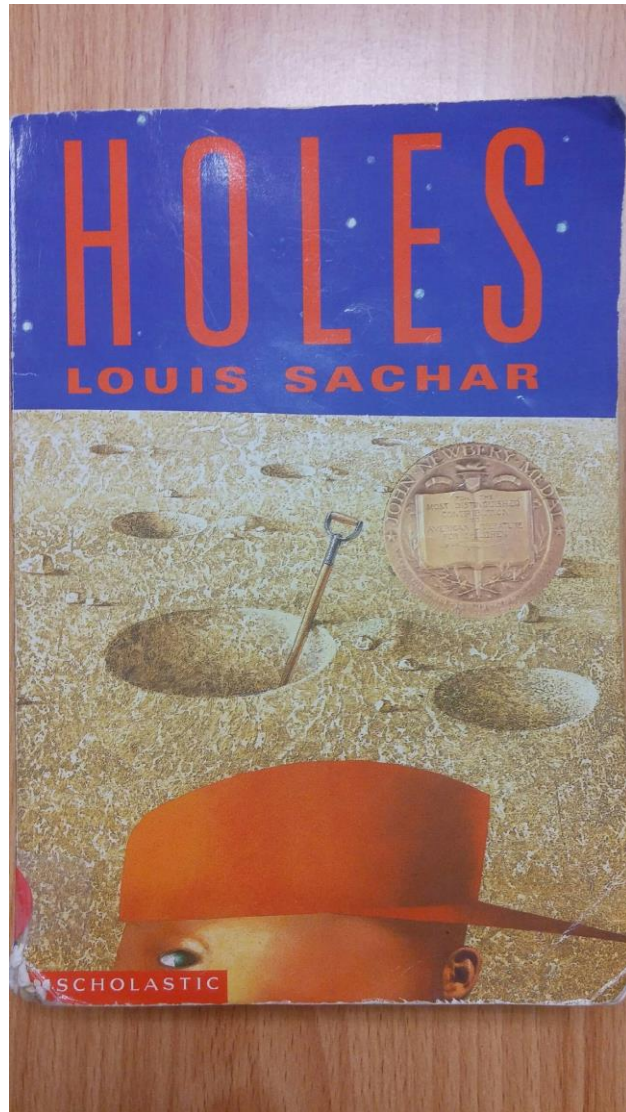
We received a gold level trophy and banner.

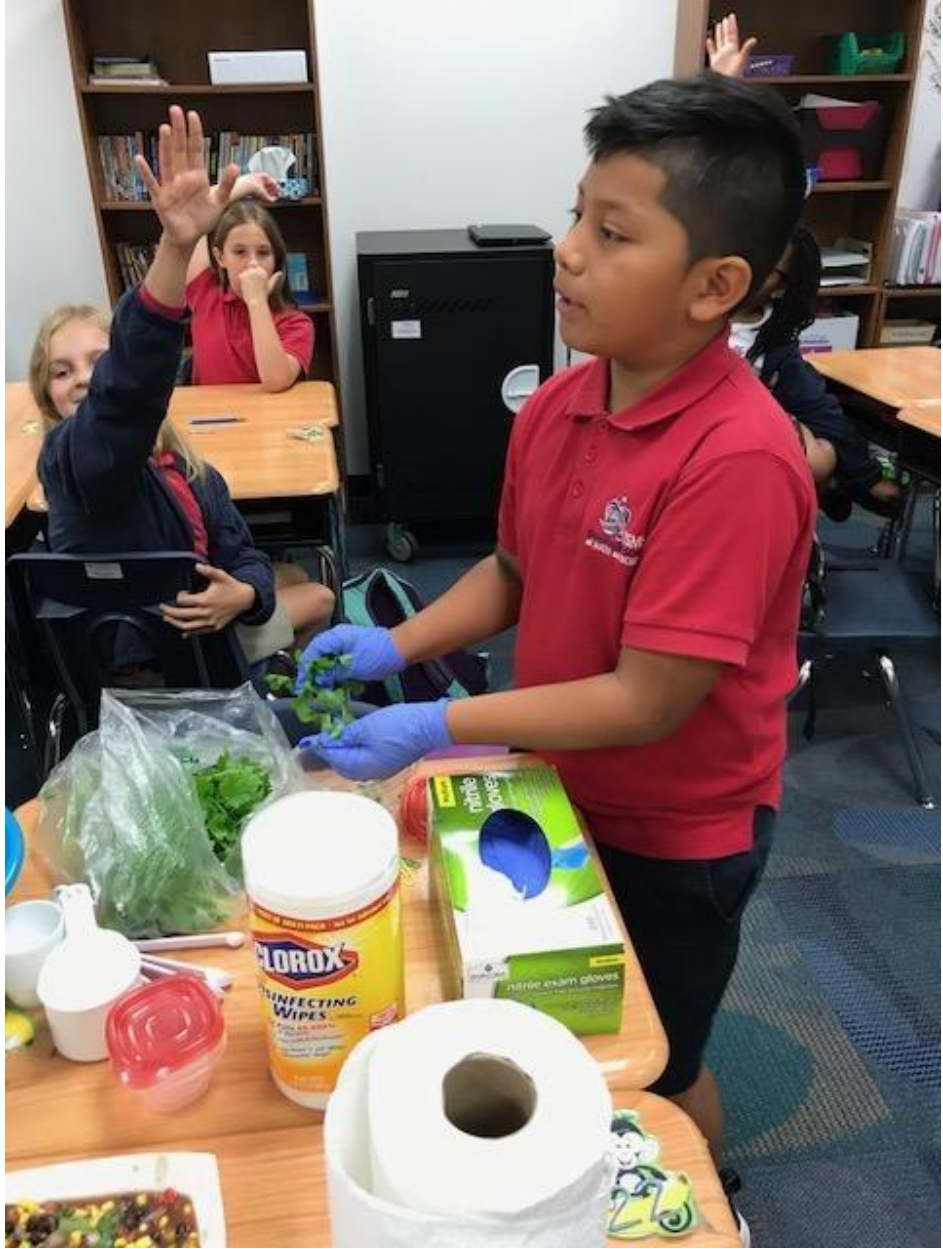
Final Nutrition Class of the Year



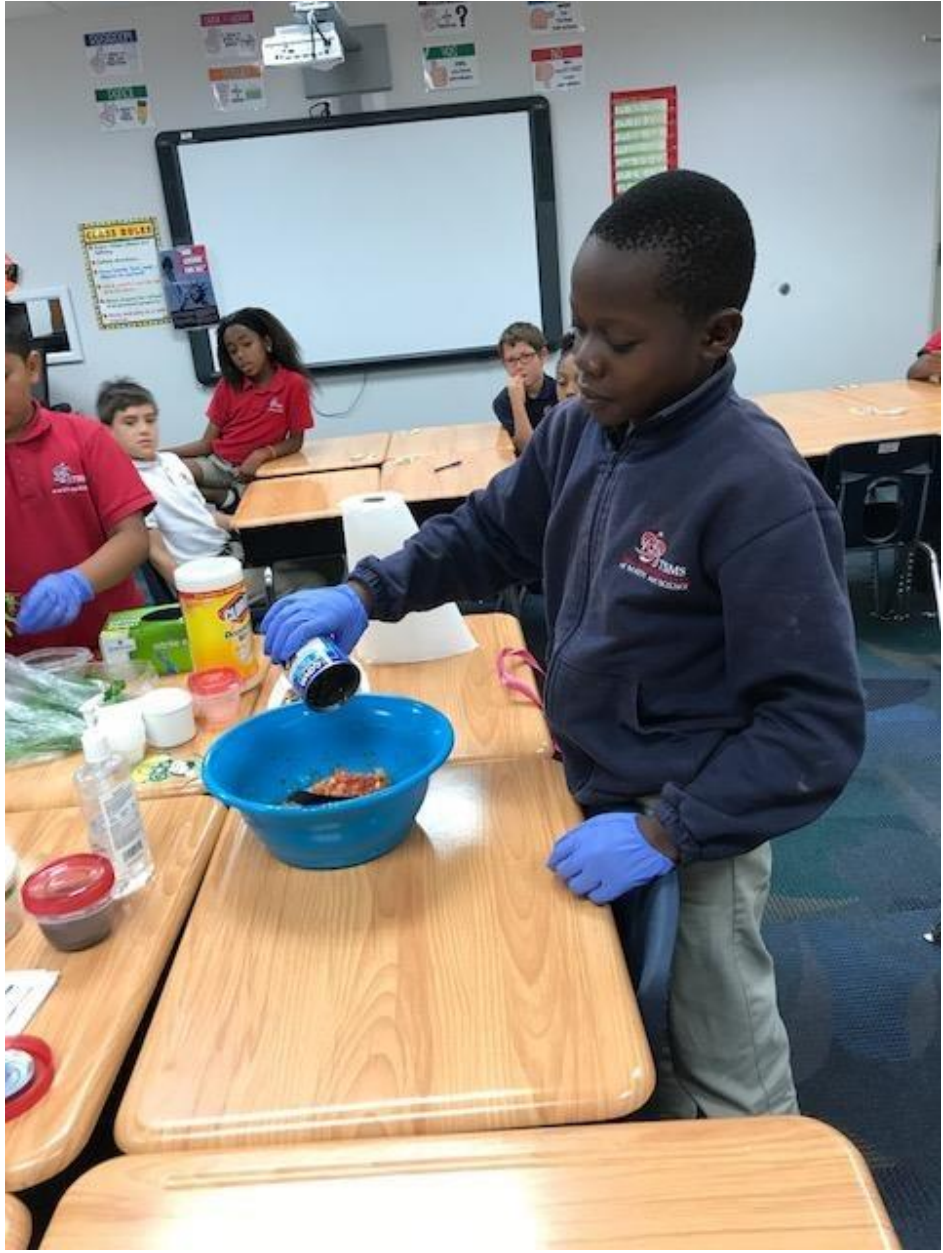

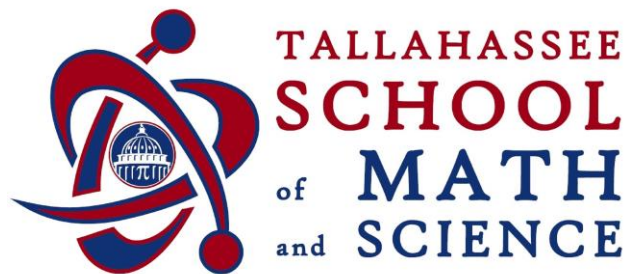
